Dear Secretary,

The Arbitration and Conciliation Act, 1996 was enacted *inter-alia* to consolidate and amend the law relating to domestic arbitration, international commercial arbitration and enforcement of foreign arbitral awards. To retain the arbitration as a mainstay mechanism for dispute resolution and also to present it as an alternative to conventional litigation, the arbitration law has undergone significant changes in the years 2015, 2019 and 2021. The changes mark a paradigm shift for ensuring timely conclusion of arbitration proceedings, minimizing judicial intervention in the arbitral process and enforcement of arbitral awards. The amendments aim at promoting institutional arbitration, embody global best practices and resolve ambiguities for establishing a robust arbitration ecosystem.

2. The Department of Legal Affairs requires information from 2015 onwards of arbitration cases where your Ministry/Department/subordinate/attached offices are a party to any arbitration matter. The information may be filled up in the enclosed format on or before 10.02.2023. You are also requested to nominate one nodal officer of your Department for proper coordination in dealing with compilation of data on arbitration cases.
